Open House on Wisconsin Point Area Management Plan to be held August 29th



The public is invited to attend and participate in an open house on August 29th, 2011 from 6-8 PM on the development of a long-range management plan for the Wisconsin Point area. The open house will take place in the meeting room of the Superior Public Library, 1530 Tower Ave. Superior, WI.

The purpose of the plan is to establish a long-range vision for Wisconsin Point and adjoining lands within the project area boundary and to provide a framework for future management of these areas.

The purpose of the open house is to provide a forum for public input to help shape a long-range vision for the project area and to be a first step toward the development of a formal management plan. Other public workshops and meetings will be held over the next 10 months as the vision is put into document form.

The “drop-in” format will allow attendees to view project area maps, listen to presentations about the current management situation and the planning process and to provide comments. Attendees will also have the opportunity to participate in group issues identification and visioning exercises.

Representatives of the project steering committee and the project consultant (Northwest Regional Planning Commission) will be present to discuss the project and answer questions.
